The Story of Big Jim

Big Jim Self was both the brains and the brawn behind Palmetto Dunes. He purchased the resort in 1979 and his vision was to create a world-class vacation destination renowned for great homes, outstanding golf, beautiful beaches, and activities for everyone.

He was a big thinker with big dreams who provided the philosophy and set the tone for Palmetto Dunes' impressive growth and development over the past 30+ years.



Standing just 5'7" and given his father's name, he was burdened with the nickname "Little Jim" for most of his life. That is until his grandkids saved the day. To his credit, he was able to convince them to call him "Big Jim", and the new name soon caught on with everyone else.

While not big in stature, Big Jim Self was bigger than life in so many ways. He graduated from The Citadel in 1941, serving with distinction in the military in WWII where he achieved the rank of Major. He was a proud father of four — two sons and two daughters. He was responsible for growing one of the world's most successful textile organizations, Greenwood Mills in Greenwood SC. His involvement with Hilton Head Island began with a conversation with Charles Fraser, the visionary behind Hilton Head. The story goes that Charles Fraser wanted to build an executive (9-hole) course at Sea Pines, but Big Jim said "no, Hilton Head needs a championship course". The Greenwood construction crews arrived a few weeks later, saying "we're here to build your golf course". And so the Sea Pines Ocean Course, the first golf course on the Island, was built on a handshake.

Jim Self was awarded honorary Doctorate degrees from seven South Carolina universities and was presented with The Order of the Palmetto, South Carolina's highest honor, given for lifetime achievement. He was also an avid hunter, fisherman, sportsman, and accomplished golfer — exercising those talents all over the world. The blue marlin on the wall, one of Big Jim's many sporting adversaries, was caught off the coast of Baja and took over four hours to land.

But one of Big Jim's biggest claims to fame has to have been his culinary skill. From his own special barbecue sauce to his renowned Tennessee coleslaw, Big Jim's recipes were always in demand among friends and family. And, whenever anyone sat down to eat at Big Jim's, they could expect nothing less than great food, great drinks, great fun, and great stories. Nothing has changed in the restaurant named in Big Jim's honor.
